The Sewerage and Water Board of New Orleans (SWBNO) contractor, Roubion Construction, will be performing a TEST closure which will temporarily disrupt your water services.

**WHEN:** Monday, October 27, 2025, from 8:00AM –12:00PM

**WHERE:** St Peter St from Bourbon St to Decatur St

**When water is restored, run your faucets for 5 minutes to flush out the lines before resuming regular use.**

**About the Project**

The replacement of the 24-inch water transmission main in the 900-1100 blocks of Decatur St. from Dumaine to Governor Nicholls Streets and the 600 block of St. Peter St. from Chartres to Royal Street is the seventh **Transmission Water Main Replacement Project** that SWBNO has replaced since 2018. This transmission main program is funded by FEMA and managed by SWBNO in cooperation with the City of New Orleans as part of the Joint Infrastructure Recovery Roads (JIRR) Program.
