



SWBNO and Entergy French Quarter Transmission Main and Gas/Electric Work Project Community Meeting

The Sewerage and Water Board of New Orleans (SWBNO) and Entergy Gas and Entergy Electric are hosting a **virtual community meeting on Thursday, March 6th** to discuss the upcoming upgrades coming to the French Quarter after Mardi Gras 2025.

Construction by Entergy is scheduled to begin on Wednesday, March 5th and will last approximately 14 months.

Construction by SWBNO is scheduled to begin in May 2025 and will last approximately 12 months. SWBNO contractor, Roubion Roads and Streets, will be replacing underground water, sewer and drainage lines, repave the roadway and replace damaged sidewalks as part of the project.

Transmission Water Main Replacement Projects

The replacement of the 24-inch water main on Decatur Street (Dumaine St – Gov Nicholls St) and St Peter Street (Chartres St – Royal St) is the seventh Transmission Water Main Replacement Project that SWBNO has replaced since 2018. The transmission main replacement program is funded by FEMA and managed by SWBNO in cooperation with the City of New Orleans as part of the Joint Infrastructure Recovery Roads (JIRR) Program. These projects are needed to proactively replace water lines as part of SWBNO's commitment to infrastructure resiliency and reliability, as outlined in our five-year strategic plan.
