WE'RE IMPROVING YOUR WATER SYSTEM – CBD, FRENCH QUARTER, GENTILLY

Residents and businesses in several different sections of the city may experience low water pressure on Monday March 7, 2016 from 1:30 p.m. through 6:30 p.m. Sewerage and Water Board crews will be performing pressure tests on waterlines in the area. On Monday any customers experiencing low water pressure should call the 52WATER (529-2837) number to report a problem.

On Tuesday, March 8, 2016 from 1:30 p.m. to 6 a.m. on Wednesday. Wallace C. Drennan Contractors will be repairing a waterline that serves these areas.
