We're Improving Your Water System- Chartres Street and Canal Street

Boh Bros Construction Company, working for the Sewerage and Water Board, will be performing a tie-in of a new water main that services the area.

Residents and businesses on Chartres Street between Canal Street and Conti Street and on Canal Street between Chartres Street and Decatur Street will experience low water pressure on Tuesday, April 12, 2016 from 11 p.m. until 7 a.m. on Wednesday April 13, 2016. This work is part of the \$188 million FEMA funded waterline replacement project.
