We’re Improving Your Water System- Louisiana Avenue

Boh Brothers Construction Company, working for the Sewerage and Water Board and the Corps of Engineers, will be cutting and capping a 12” water line that services the area.

Residents and businesses on Louisiana Avenue from Camp Street to Constance Street will experience low water pressure on Wednesday, May 25, 2016 from 8 a.m. to 12 p.m., noon. This work is part of the \$82.6 million SELA Louisiana Avenue Canal Project.
