Sewerage and Water Board crews will be repairing water lines and hydrants that serve the area.

Residents and businesses in the Riverbend Area, inside the boundary of Joliet Street, Leake Avenue, Zimpel Street and Adams Street, will experience low water pressure on Sunday, June 12, 2016 from 8 a.m. until 4 p.m.

Traffic Advisory

Motorists are advised that they will experience some traffic delays on Saturday and Sunday, June 11 and June 12, 2016. On both days, traffic delays will occur from 8 a.m. until 6 p.m. on St. Charles Avenue from Short Street to S. Carrollton Avenue and at the intersection of St. Charles Avenue and S. Carrollton Avenue. Traffic will be reduced to one travel lane.
