We're improving your sewer system – CBD Traffic Advisory

Contractors working for the Sewerage and Water Board will perform sewer service pipe installation work.

Residents, businesses and motorists are advised that Gravier Street between Loyola Avenue and S. Rampart Street will be closed to vehicular traffic beginning at 6 p.m. on Tuesday, July 5, 2016 to 2 a.m. on Wednesday morning, July 6, 2016.

The following detour will be in place:

Southbound traffic on South Rampart Street will be detoured onto Common Street. The eastbound lane of Common Street will be closed from Loyola Avenue to S. Rampart Street. Tulane Avenue/Common Street eastbound will be detoured north and south on Loyola Avenue.

We appreciate your patience as we work to improve the city's infrastructure.
