We're Improving Your Water System/ Emergency Repair – Algiers Area

Sewerage and Water Board crews are continuing to perform an emergency repair to a 24" water main near the intersection of LeBoeuf Street and Diana Street that ruptured Monday evening.

Residents and businesses on several streets in the area may experience low water pressure until the repair is completed. L. B. Landry High School will experience low water pressure until the repair is completed. Further updates will be provided as more information becomes available.
