We’re improving your drainage system – Traffic Advisory – Jefferson Avenue

Weather permitting, Cajun Construction, working for the Corps of Engineers and the Sewerage and Water Board will **perform roadway striping that will affect traffic flow and parking in your area.**

Residents, businesses and motorists are advised that Jefferson Avenue at the intersection of Magazine Street will have one lane of traffic alternating for eastbound and westbound traffic beginning at **7 a.m. on Monday, September 26, 2015 until 5 p.m.** Vehicles traveling on Magazine Street will not be able to turn onto Jefferson Avenue until asphalt has had time to cure.

Flaggers and signage will be in place at Octavia Street and Valmont Street to direct vehicles.
