We're Improving Your Water System – Lower Ninth Ward

The Sewerage and Water Board and the Corps of Engineers will perform waterline work on a large water main that serves the Lower Ninth Ward. Boh Brothers Construction Company, working for the Board and the Corps of Engineers will tie in a new 48" water main that serves the area.

Residents and businesses in the Lower Ninth Ward are not expected to experience low water pressure during the work that will occur on **Friday, September 30, 2016 at 5 p.m. until Sunday, October 2, 2016 at 5p.m.** However, if you experience pressure loss while this work is being performed, please notify us at 52-WATER(529-2837) so that we can attempt to adjust your pressure.

This work is part of the \$119 million SELA Florida Avenue Canal Phase 2-3 Drainage Project.

We appreciate your patience as we work to improve the City's infrastructure.
