We're Improving Your Water System – S. Carrollton Avenue

Sewerage and Water Board crews will **perform waterline repair work** on S. Carrollton Avenue on **Sunday, April 2, 2017**. This work will also affect traffic flow.

Residents and businesses on S. Carrollton Avenue from Spruce to Jeanette Streets will experience low water pressure on **Sunday, April 2, 2017 from 8 a.m. to 3 p.m.**

Motorists are advised that the east side of **S. Carrollton Avenue from Freret Street to Oak Street** will have the left lane closed to traffic **on Saturday, April 1 from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m.** Also the west side of **S. Carrollton Avenue from Cohn Street to Hickory Street** will have one lane closed on **Sunday, April 2, 2017 from 8 a.m. to 3 p.m.**

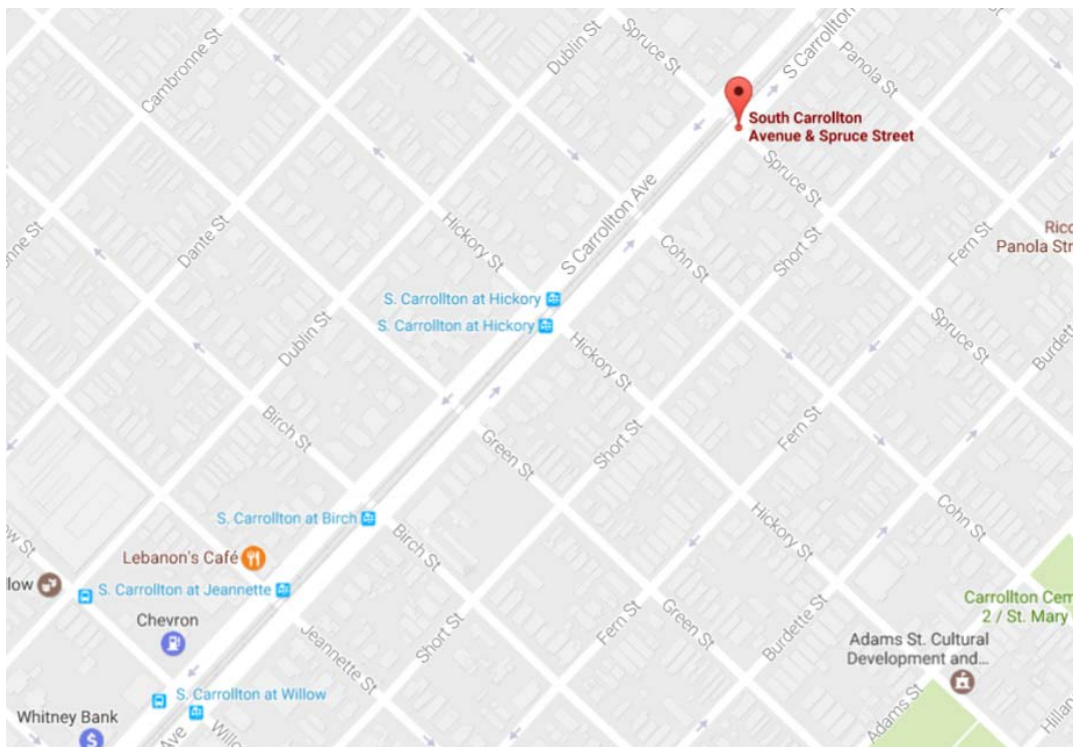

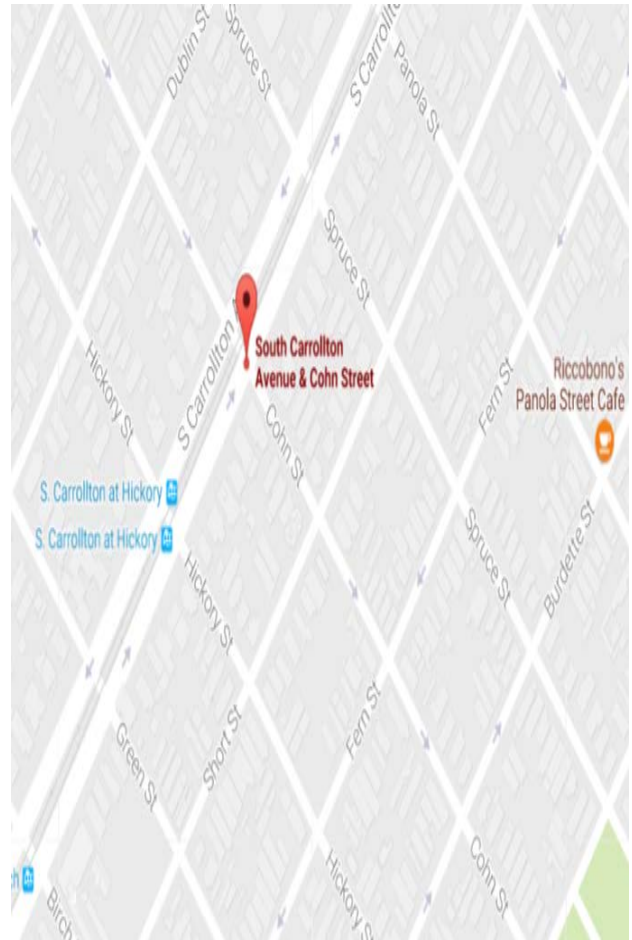
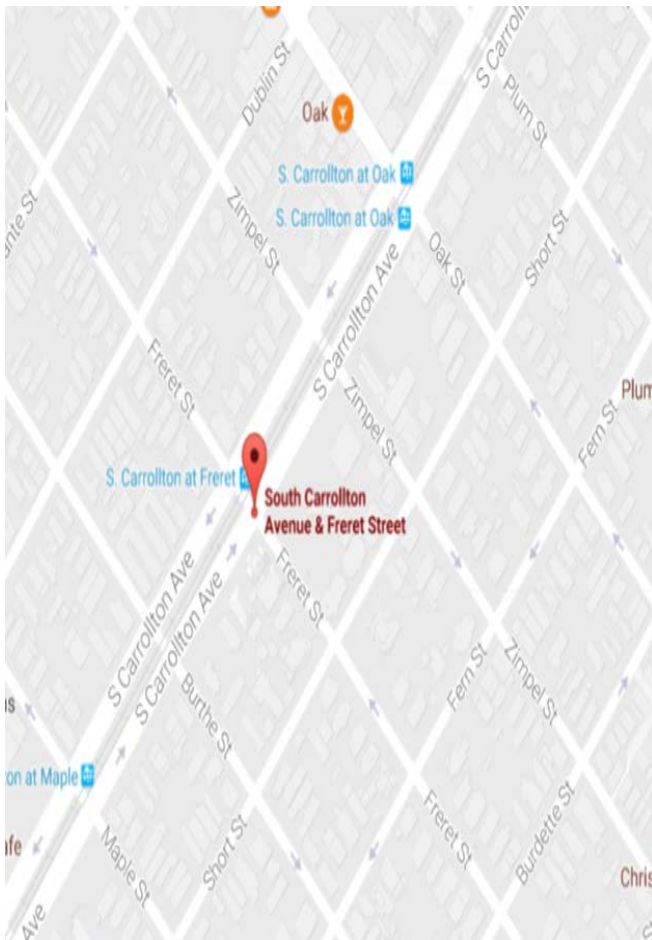
