Residents and businesses in the Gentilly area will experience low water pressure on **Saturday, June 24, 2017 from 8 a.m. to 3 p.m.**

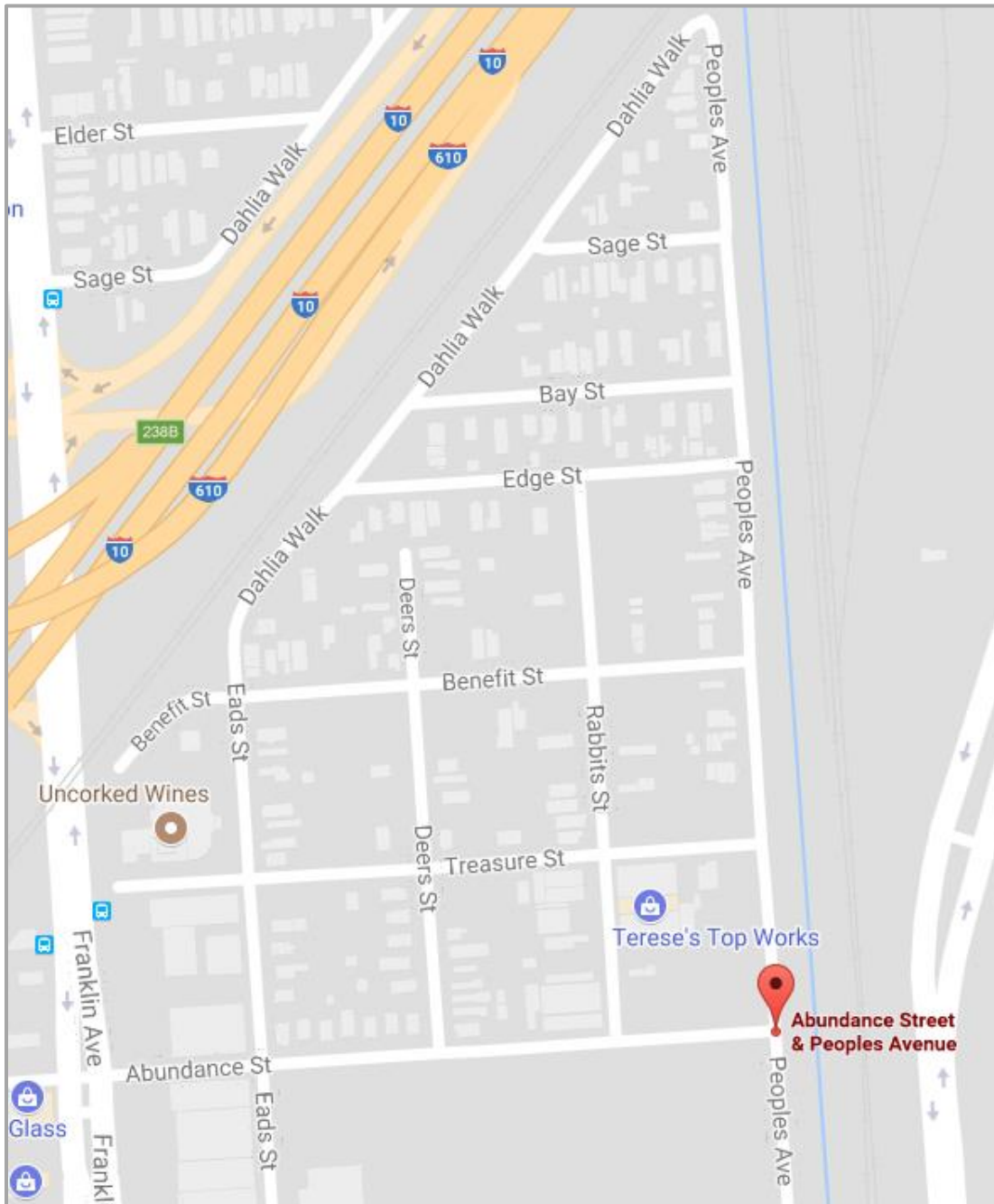
