Low Water Pressure in CBD

Businesses in a small portion of Poydras Street in the Central Business District will experience low water pressure on Friday, October 19, 2012 beginning at 11 p.m. through Saturday, October 20 at 5 a.m.

Contractors working for the Regional Transit Authority (RTA) constructing the new Loyola Avenue Streetcar Line project will be making a tie-in to a major water main that serves the business district.

The area affected is Poydras Street from South Rampart Street to South Claiborne Avenue.
