Sewerage and Water Board to Perform Water Line Closure on 4/17/18, Encourages CBD Residents to Report Changes in Water Pressure

NEW ORLEANS – Sewerage and Water Board crews will be performing a closure of a water line on Tuesday, April 17th. The duration of the work will be from 6 a.m. to 4 p.m. The purpose of this closure is to make preparation for a repair on a 43" water main.


Residents and businesses in the Central Business District (CBD) may experience low water pressure on Tuesday, April 17, 2018. There will be a controlled closure with pressures closely monitored. S&WB employees will constantly monitor water pressure and assess the impact on any affected area.

However, during the test closure, S&WB is asking customers to report any changes in water pressure by calling 52-WATER (529-2837). Should there be drops in water pressure, the controlled closure can be ended immediately.

We appreciate your patience as we work to improve the City's infrastructure.
