Low Water Pressure – Common Street

Residents and businesses on Common Street between St. Charles Avenue and Carondelet Street and on Carondelet Street from Gravier Street to Canal Street will experience low water pressure overnight beginning at 10 p.m. on Thursday, April 16, 2015 through 6 a.m. on Friday, April 17, 2015.

Boh Brothers Construction Company will complete a tie-in of a new water line to serve the area.

This work is part of the \$183 million Sewerage & Water Board/FEMA Funded Waterline Replacement Program.
