Low Water Pressure-Exchange Place (Canal-Iberville)

Residents and businesses on Exchange Place between Canal Street and Iberville Street will experience low water pressure overnight for two nights beginning on Monday, May 18th at 10 p.m. through Tuesday, May 19th at 6 a.m. and again on Tuesday night, May 19th at 10 p.m. through Wednesday, May 20th at 6 a.m.

Boh Brothers Construction Company will perform this two-part project to repair and tie-in a new water line to serve the area.

This work is part of the \$184 million Sewerage & Water Board/FEMA Funded Waterline Replacement Project.
