CORRECTION: Low Water Pressure in South Claiborne Avenue Area

Residents and businesses in the S. Claiborne Avenue area will experience low water pressure on Thursday, August 6, 2015 from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. while Cajun Construction ties in a new 8" water line.

This work is part of the \$27.1 million Sewerage and Water Board/Corps of Engineers SELA South Claiborne Avenue Drainage Canal Project Phase 1.

Blocks affected are:

South Claiborne Avenue between General Ogden and Joliet.

Joliet Street between South Claiborne Avenue and Apricot.
