LOW WATER PRESSURE/TRAFFIC ADVISORY – UPTOWN AREA

Residents and businesses in a large section of the Uptown area will experience low water pressure from 8 p.m. on Thursday, September 24, 2015 through 5 a.m. on Friday, September 25, 2015, while Sewerage and Water Board crews repair a series of valves on waterlines that serve the uptown area.
