Traffic Advisory – Broadway Street between Green and Plum streets
Uptown University Area

Residents, businesses and motorists are advised that the riverbound side of Broadway Street between Willow and Plum streets, and the riverbound side of Broadway Street between Green and Birch streets will be undergoing paving restoration starting at 7am on Saturday, October 24, 2015 through 6pm Sunday, October 25, 2015. In addition, final restoration will take place on Monday, October 26, 2015 from 8am to 12pm.

Contractors working for the Sewerage and Water Board will perform surface restorations to last week's water line repairs. Remaining work includes street surface removal and asphalt overlay. Full lane closures on the riverbound side of Broadway Street will expedite the restoration process in anticipation of inclement weather next week.
