Residents and businesses on Coliseum Street between Constantinople Street and Napoleon Avenue will experience low water pressure on Wednesday, January 13, 2016 from 8 a.m. until 3:30 p.m.

Boh Brothers Construction Company, working for the Corps of Engineers and the Sewerage and Water Board, will be performing a tie-in of a 20" water line in the area. This work is part of the SELA Urban Flood Improvement Program.
