Residents and businesses on Carondelet Street between Louisiana Avenue and 6th Street and on Baronne Street between Louisiana Avenue and 6th Street will experience low water pressure on Wednesday, January 27, 2016 from 8 a.m. until 4 p.m.

Boh Brothers Construction Company, working for the Corps of Engineers and Sewerage and Water Board, will be performing a tie-in of a water line that services the area. This work is part of the \$82.6 million Louisiana Avenue Canal, SELA Urban Flood Improvement Program.
