We’re improving your water system - Low Water Pressure/Traffic Advisory – Uptown, French Quarter, CBD, and Warehouse District

Residents, businesses and motorists are advised that customers in the Uptown Area, French Quarter, CBD, and Warehouse District, will experience low water pressure on Thursday February 25, 2016 10 a.m. to 1 p.m. while Sewerage and Water Board crews make assessments to repair a 30” water main valve.

Due to valve assessment work at Earhart and Magnolia the right lane traveling westbound will be closed. Motorists are advised that a right turn onto Earhart Boulevard from Magnolia St. will not be allowed while work is in progress. All traffic will be advised to turn right onto Earhart Boulevard from Clio St.

We appreciate your patience as we work to improve the City’s infrastructure.
